Section 1: Course Completion Plan for Cecil College

This section outlines the courses to satisfy Cecil College (Cec) general education and program requirements in order to complete both Cecil and Towson University (TU) degrees within a total of four years and earn the minimum required 120 units/credits.¹ The following tables do not include any nontransferable or prerequisite coursework outside of the curriculum.
