### **Recommendations for TU Degree Completion**

Electives will be waived for students earning the AAT degree with a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.

The Special Education program at TU requires a minimum GPA of 3.00 during the undergraduate education. A grade of Pass is not accepted for courses required in the undergraduate program. Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, or Cambridge can be applied to the undergraduate program.

Students in all majors are required to maintain a semester GPA of 3.00 in required education. For students in the Professional Internship program, students follow the school system calendar of the Professional Internship program when they are assigned.

Students must complete all required courses and prerequisites.
